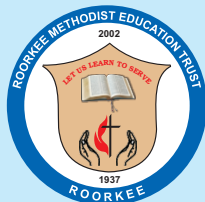

ABOUT THE COLLEGE

Methodist Girls' P.G. College, a minority institution recognized by the National Commission, Government of India, was established in 2002. It is located on NH-58, in the heart of Roorkee, just 1 km from the bus stand and 3 km from the railway station.

The college is affiliated to H.N.B. Garhwal University, Srinagar Garhwal, and Sri Dev Suman University, and is dedicated exclusively to female education, with over 1,400 students enrolled from Roorkee and surrounding areas.

Governed by its Management Committee, the college operates under the Roorkee Methodist Education Trust, with its headquarters in Mumbai. The Methodist Society in India aims to provide higher education for women and society at large, upholding the motto "LEARN TO SERVE."

In 2002, the Bachelor of Arts (B.A.) course was introduced with seven subjects: Hindi, English, History, Political Science, Home Science, Economics, and Sociology, under the affiliation of H.N.B. Garhwal University, Srinagar. In 2005, the Bachelor of Commerce (B.Com.) course was introduced under the affiliation of H.N.B. Garhwal University, Srinagar. In the year 2010, Master of Commerce (M.Com) & in 2012 Master of Arts (M.A.) in Hindi, English & Home-Science were introduced. In 2013, the Bachelor of Science (B.Sc.) program was introduced with two streams: 1) Physics, Chemistry, Mathematics (PCM). 2) Chemistry, Biology, Zoology (CBZ). From 2018, the Master of Science (M.Sc.) program in Chemistry and Mathematics. The above B.Sc and M.Sc courses are affiliated to Sri Dev Suman University, Uttarakhand.
